Welcome Guest Pastor Tim Bias: Rev. Dr. Timothy L. Bias was appointed West Ohio Conference Superintendent assigned to the Capital Area South district in July of 2016. With 42 years of appointive history, Rev. Bias brings to the ministry of superintending an exceptional range of experience in rural and urban pastoral ministry as well as district, conference and denominational leadership. He is a visionary leader, strategic thinker, teacher and author who feels passionately about the importance of developing relationships to further ministry and make disciples for Christ. A graduate of Marshall University, Pastor Tim received his Master of Divinity from the Candler School of Theology at Emory University in 1980 and his Doctor of Ministry from United Theological Seminary in 1991. He was ordained as an Elder in The United Methodist Church in 1981. Tim is married to Kimberly Raynes and they have two children and three grandchildren.
